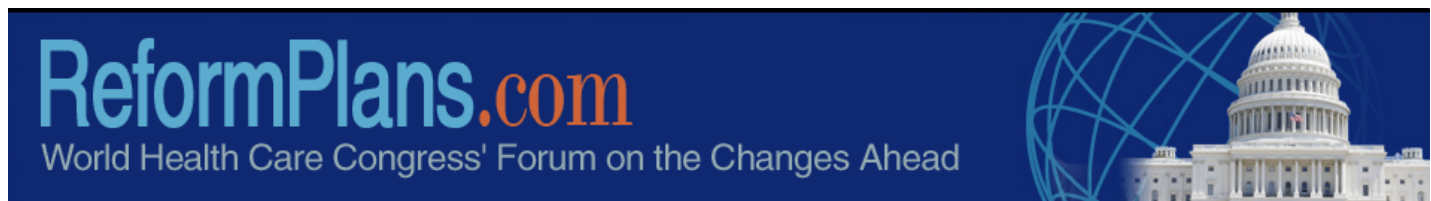

Gupta predicts a "revolution" in health care brought about by information technology: "IT security will eventually meet the expectations of the health-care industry, just as has happened in other sectors, like banking. And when it does, powerful IT networks crisscrossing the globe will change the way much of health care is delivered." he says. Once this system evolves, Gupta says three types of health care delivery will exist: services performed in person, those performed remotely, and services provided entirely by computer. Not surprisingly, Gupta says "These changes won't come quickly." That's the big question most people would like answered, when is this IT revolution going to happen, and how will it be financed.
